Ostróda County occupies and area of 176,629 ha in the western part of the Warmia-Masuria Province (north-eastern Poland). In terms of area, is is the 17th largest county in Poland and 4th within the Province. From the north, the County borders Elbl?g and Lidzbark, from the east – Olsztyn, from the south – Dzia?dowo and Nidzica, and from the west – Sztum and I?awa. Geographically, the County is located in the I?awa Lake District, the core area of a powerful tourism brand – Western Masuria. Ostróda is located at the intersection of the following routes: Pozna?-Olsztyn and Warsaw-Gda?sk (national roads: S7, No. 15 and 16). The County is also conveniently connected by railway. Railway line from Olsztyn to Wroc?aw, which intersects with the Warsaw-Gda?sk route in the nearby I?awa, also passes through Ostróda. The railway from Olsztyn to Elbl?g runs through the communes of Ma?dyty and Mor?g.
